This cache is part of the Great White North Geotour. This multi will give you a short tour of Victoria taking you to some lovely views and places to enjoy Victoria life. The final will offer you a stunning view and a little exercise.

You must go to the locations shown in the "additional waypoints" listed below and answer the questions shown under those waypoint listings. Only after you have answered all five questions will you be able to find the final.

Once you have the answers A, B, C, and D then you must:

Multiply answer A and B together, call the result E.

Add C and D together, call the result F

Add the four digit number E to 21192. Place the result in the blanks in the following coordinate: **48deg** \_ .. \_ \_ minutes North

Add the four digit number F to 28713. Place the result in the blanks in the following coordinate: **123deg** \_ .. \_ \_ minutes West

The final is a short projection from the coordinates you've just found. Go to the coordinates you've just found and look down at your feet. You should see a year marked on a small marker... the last two digits are "answer G".

Add the last two digits of the year shown on the marker (answer G) to 283 call this answer "Bearing".
